Welcome to www.dr-dog.org.

These Terms of Use govern your access to and use of the Dr. Dog website and its content, features, donation links, communications, and other online resources.

By accessing or using this website, you agree to these Terms of Use. If you do not agree with these Terms, please discontinue use of the website.

For purposes of these Terms, "Dr. Dog," "we," "us," or "our" refers, as applicable, to Dr. Dog Animal Shelter / Asociación Civil SEBRA, based in Limpio, Paraguay, and Non-Profit Dr. Dog Inc., a United States nonprofit organization supporting the Dr. Dog mission.

1. Our Mission and Website

Dr. Dog is dedicated to the rescue, protection, care, rehabilitation, and welfare of dogs.

The website provides information about our organization, rescued animals, programs, activities, shelter, supporters, partnerships, donation opportunities, and ways for individuals and organizations to become involved.

Website content is provided primarily for informational and charitable purposes.

2. Use of the Website

You agree to use the website only for lawful purposes.

You may not:

- Attempt to gain unauthorized access to the website, servers, accounts, or systems
- Introduce viruses, malicious code, or other harmful technology
- Interfere with the operation or security of the website
- Use automated systems to improperly collect information from the website
- Misrepresent your identity or affiliation
- Use the website to engage in unlawful, fraudulent, abusive, defamatory, threatening, or harmful conduct
- Copy or commercially exploit website content without authorization

We may restrict or terminate access to the website when reasonably necessary to protect the organization, its users, systems, animals, staff, volunteers, or supporters.

3. Donations

Donations made in support of Dr. Dog are voluntary charitable contributions.

Donations may be processed directly or through independent third-party payment processors, charitable-giving platforms, workplace-giving platforms, or fundraising services.

Those services may have their own terms, conditions, privacy policies, fees, and procedures.

Unless a campaign expressly states otherwise, donations support Dr. Dog's charitable mission and may be used where reasonably needed to advance animal rescue, care, veterinary treatment, food, shelter operations, infrastructure, staffing, rehabilitation, and other mission-related expenses.

A reference to a particular animal, project, or need does not necessarily create a legally restricted donation unless Dr. Dog expressly confirms that the contribution is restricted for that purpose.

4. Donation Receipts and Tax Matters

The tax treatment of a donation depends on the organization receiving the contribution, the donor's jurisdiction, and applicable law.

Non-Profit Dr. Dog Inc. is identified as a United States 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Donations intended to qualify for United States charitable tax treatment must be made through an eligible U.S. entity or approved donation channel and remain subject to applicable U.S. law.

Contributions made to entities or programs outside the United States may be treated differently.

Dr. Dog does not provide tax, accounting, or legal advice. Donors should consult their own professional adviser regarding tax deductibility.

5. Donation Errors and Refunds

Charitable donations are generally final.

However, if a donation was made in error, duplicated, processed incorrectly, or involved unauthorized use of a payment method, please contact us promptly.

Refund requests will be reviewed individually and may also be subject to the rules of the payment processor or charitable-giving platform through which the donation was made.

Nothing in this section limits any rights required by applicable law.

6. Adoption, Rescue, and Volunteer Information

Information provided through the website regarding dogs, adoption, volunteering, visits, rescue activities, sponsorships, or other opportunities does not constitute a guarantee of acceptance or availability.

Dr. Dog may establish eligibility, safety, welfare, operational, and animal-care requirements before approving an adoption, shelter visit, volunteer activity, partnership, or similar arrangement.

The welfare and safety of the animals remain a primary consideration.

7. Veterinary and Animal-Care Information

Information about animal health, veterinary care, treatment, rehabilitation, nutrition, behavior, or similar subjects is provided for general informational purposes only.

It is not a substitute for diagnosis, treatment, or advice from a licensed veterinarian or other qualified animal-care professional.

8. Accuracy of Information

We make reasonable efforts to maintain accurate and current information.

However, rescue situations and nonprofit operations can change quickly. Animal availability, statistics, programs, partners, campaigns, shelter needs, photographs, donation opportunities, and other website information may change without notice.

We do not warrant that every item of website content will always be complete, current, or error-free.

9. Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise indicated, the website and its original content - including text, photographs, graphics, videos, logos, designs, stories, and other materials - are owned by or used with permission by Dr. Dog and are protected by applicable intellectual-property laws.

You may share public Dr. Dog content through normal social-media sharing functions for personal, noncommercial purposes and to help promote our charitable mission.
